## Target:

### Article Three - Staff, Section 320 - Contracting Authority

## Current:

**SECTION 320 - CONTRACTING AUTHORITY** - No Officer or Committee of the Department shall enter into or sign any contract or agreement for the purpose of binding the Department without first submitting said contract or agreement to the Judge Advocate for consideration and written recommendation to the Board. The Board thereafter by majority vote shall accept or reject, in whole or part, the contract or agreement submitted to it.

## Proposed Revision:

**SECTION 320 - CONTRACTING AUTHORITY** - No department officer, committee chairman, or other member of any department shall enter into or sign any contract or agreement for the purpose of binding the department without first submitting such contract or agreement to the Department Board of Trustees. All documents shall be forwarded to the entire Department Board of Trustees for approval, amendments, or rejections.
